SOUTH REGION HIGHLIGHTS

- Bartley Ranch was one of the KTMB Christmas tree recycling locations from Dec. 26th through January 7th. They will be mulched on site where the mulch will be used for weed control and site improvements.
- The Galena Creek Visitors Center at Galena Creek Regional Park held weekend programs including snowshoeing and will continue through the winter season on most weekends.
- Bowers Mansion repairs phase III received bids for the work to be done in 2020. The work is scheduled to be completed by mid-June 2020.

UPCOMING EVENTS

- Bartley Ranch Regional Park will host the Come in from the Cold series beginning on January 11th and continuing through March 7th.
