PLANNING HIGHLIGHTS

- Several planting projects were completed using volunteers including tree planting at North Valleys Regional Park, native shrub planting at Bartley Ranch Regional Park, and native shrub planting at Crystal Peak Park.
- Soil-Tech was contracted to complete spring noxious weed treatments at Bartley Ranch Regional Park, Anderson Park, Cold Springs Park, Rancho San Rafael Regional Park, Riverbend Open Space, Carcione Open Space, Crystal Peak Park, Lockwood Trailhead, Dorostkar Park, and Mayberry Park.
- The Carcione and Canepa Ranch Recreation Access Plan is nearing completion and will be presented to the Park Commission at its June meeting.
- The Riverbend boundary line adjustment is expected to be finalized in the coming weeks. Staff are hoping to move forward with construction of the trailhead and river path this fall, pending distribution of Land and Water Conservation Fund grant monies. Staff will present an update on this project at an upcoming Park Commission meeting.
- Blackstone Estates Park, located in Spanish Springs, (which was funded partially with Residential Construction Tax funds but will be maintained by the Blackstone Estates HOA) has been completed. Staff have conducted an inspection and several updates are required before park maintenance transfers to the HOA.
