



HSA Contribution Limit Worksheet

The Health Savings Account (HSA) allows you to contribute pre-tax dollars to pay for health care expenses, such as deductibles, co-pays and co-insurance. However, you are only eligible to participate in an HSA if you enroll in the High Deductible Health Plan (HDHP). Annual contribution limits are set by the IRS. For 2023, they are \$3,850 for individual coverage and \$7,750 for family coverage. If you are age 55 or over, you can contribute an additional \$1,000 per year. See the tables below to find out your max payroll contribution limit.

Single Contribution (Under 55 yrs old)

Catch-up Contribution	+	\$1,000
2023 Washoe County Contribution	-	\$2,250
Your Max Contribution for 2023	=	\$2,600

Family Contribution (55 yrs or older)		
2023 IRS Limit		\$7,750
Catch-up Contribution	+	\$1,000
2023 Washoe County Contribution	-	\$2,500
Your Max Contribution for 2023	=	\$6,250

*Washoe County contribution amounts are for those enrolled as of 1/1/2023. A pro-rated contribution shall be provided for those enrolled after this date.
