



State Route 431 and 28 Construction Resumes May 1

Traffic Control

The third construction season of State Route 431 and 28 improvements is scheduled to begin **Monday, May 1, weather dependent.**

For the first few weeks of the season, normal working hours are from **Sundays 8:00 p.m.- Fridays at 7 p.m.** All work is weather permitting and excludes major holidays.

Drivers can expect multiple work zones and up to 30-minute delays with single lane, flagger-controlled closures.

Commercial vehicles with air brakes (26,000 pounds or greater) are prohibited from traveling westbound over Mt. Rose Summit from Mt. Rose Ski Resort to Incline Village. Trucks will be allowed traveling eastbound from Incline Village to Reno. Nevada Highway Patrol (NHP) officers will be monitoring.

Your understanding and patience is appreciated as we work to improve Nevada highways.



NDOT SR 431-28 TAHOE PROJECT

Construction begins May 2023, weather dependent.

The Nevada Department of Transportation and Q&D Construction are entering into the third working season of revitalizing and enhancing the existing roadway and utility system along portions of SR 431 and SR 28. These improvements, along with others, will help preserve pavement and protect Lake Tahoe.

Traffic Control

During the construction season and working hours:

- Traffic will be reduced to a single lane in work zones. Flaggers will control traffic flow in these areas. Drivers can expect multiple work zones and up to 30-minute delays.
- Commercial vehicles with air brakes not permitted westbound on SR 431 over Mt. Rose Summit from Mt. Rose Ski to Incline Village. Restrictions will be lifted once work on Mt. Rose concludes.
- Full road closures on side streets are possible. Access and detour routes will be provided in advance.

Working Hours

Includes daytime and nighttime hours (24-hours a day). All work is weather permitting and excludes major holidays.

- Normal working hours: Sundays 8:00 p.m. - Fridays noon
- Early and late season hours: Sundays 8:00 p.m. - Fridays 7:00 p.m.

- SR 28: Installing ITS conduit through Incline Village (Northwood Blvd. to Ponderosa Ranch Rd.)
- · SR 28: Guardrail, curb, gutter and ADA ramp installation through Crystal Bay
- SR 431: Milling and repaving the roadway between Country Club Dr. and the roundabout
- · Marlette Creek: IVGID relocating utilities

- JUNE SR 28: Installing ITS conduit through Incline Village (Northwood Blvd. to Ponderosa Ranch Rd.)
 - SR 28: Guardrail, curb, gutter and ADA ramp installation through Crystal Bay
 - SR 431: Milling and repaving the roadway between Country Club Dr. and the roundabout
 - · Marlette Creek: IVGID relocating utilities

JULY

- SR 28: Milling and repaving the roadway from the roundabout west through Crystal Bay
- · Marlette Creek: Installing new storm drain and detention basin
- · Marlette Creek: Placing concrete curb and gutter

AUG

- SR 28: Milling and repaving the roadway from the roundabout west through Crystal Bay
- · SR 28: Guardrail, curb and gutter installation through Incline Village
- · Marlette Creek: Installing new storm drain and detention basin
- · Marlette Creek: Placing concrete curb and gutter

SEP

- SR 28: Guardrail, curb and gutter installation through Incline Village
- SR 28: Milling and repaying the roadway from the roundabout east to Ponderosa Ranch Rd.

OCT

- SR 28: Guardrail, curb and gutter installation through Incline Village
- SR 28: Milling and repaving the roadway from the roundabout east to Ponderosa Ranch Rd.
