**SUBJECT:** Recommendation to award a bid and approve the Agreement to the lowest responsive, responsible bidder for the Ventana Parkway Improvement Project [staff recommends Sierra Nevada Construction, Inc., in the amount of \$1,016,007.00]. (Commission District 2.)

### SUMMARY

The Ventana Parkway Improvement project (Attachment A) consists of 1.3 miles of roadbed modification with new asphalt pavement for the base bid as shown below.

Sealed bids for the Ventana Parkway Improvement Project were opened on May 21, 2015. The list of bids received for the project is as follows:

Washoe County Strategic Objective supported by this item: Safe, secure and healthy communities.

### **PREVIOUS ACTION**

On July 8, 2014 the Board of County Commissioners (Board) approved a Cooperative Agreement for Washoe County Roadway Maintenance Projects between Washoe County and the Nevada Department of Transportation, which canceled a previous Cooperative Agreement and subsequent Amendment No. 1 for Eastlake Boulevard Improvement Project; and accepted state funds in the amount of \$6 million for road maintenance projects within unincorporated Washoe County in accordance with the agreement.

### **BACKGROUND**

The repair and maintenance of County streets is part of the Community Services Department's pavement infrastructure preservation program. The objective of the maintenance program is to help keep the County's maintenance and replacement costs at a minimum. This is accomplished by performing selected maintenance (i.e., patch repair, crack sealing, slurry seals, overlays or reconstruction) when the Pavement Condition Index (PCI) falls below certain levels.

The Ventana Parkway project consists of roadbed modification with micro seal construction of approximately 7,085 lineal feet of Ventana Parkway in the Truckee Meadows area. This is the second of three planned projects utilizing the \$6 million in funding accepted from the State of Nevada in July of 2014 for Washoe County Roadway Maintenance Projects. The first project, Eastlake Boulevard Improvement Project, was completed in October 2014.

### **FISCAL IMPACT**

The Ventana Parkway Improvement project is fully funded through revenue received from NDOT pursuant to a Cooperative Agreement approved by the Board in July of 2014. Funding in the amount of \$1,016,007.00 for this contract is available in the Roads Special Revenue Fund (216) FY15 budget in Internal Order 20397.

### **RECOMMENDATION**

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners award a bid and approve the Agreement to the lowest responsive, responsible bidder for the Ventana Parkway Improvement Project [staff recommends Sierra Nevada Construction, Inc., in the amount of \$1,016,007.00].

### **POSSIBLE MOTION**

Should the Board agree with staff's recommendation, a possible motion would be. "Move to award a bid and approve the Agreement to the lowest responsive, responsible bidder for the Ventana Parkway Improvement Project [staff recommends Sierra Nevada Construction, Inc., in the amount of \$1,016,007.00]."
