Overview of the EMAP Accreditation

- Voluntary, non-governmental process of self-assessment and external independent peer review
- Evaluates an Emergency Management Program's organization, resources, plans, processes, procedures, and capabilities against the *Emergency Management Standard*
- Peer assess the degree to which an Emergency Management Program achieves compliance with the criteria established in the *Emergency Management Standard*
- ► EMAP Accreditation Process provides a mechanism for critical, objective, and constructive review

The Emergency Management Standard

- ▶ Rigorous, industry standard for Emergency Management Programs
- Defines "what" a high-quality Emergency Management Program is rather than "how" any particular function or activity is conducted

Application of the *Emergency Management Standard*

- ▶ What constitutes the Emergency Management Program
- Internal and external stakeholders must be involved in the EMAP Accreditation Process

► Emergency Management Program determines how compliance with the *Emergency Management Standard* will best be demonstrated




