

2023 Legislative Session Week 3 Report February 20 to February 24, 2023

Bills of Interest

<u>AB 2</u> – Allows for use of blue lights on certain vehicles.

AB 52 – Makes various changes to the Open Meeting Law

<u>AB 63</u> - Requires the Director of the Department of Transportation and the Director of the Department of Public Safety to review, study and prepare reports regarding certain issues relating to traffic safety. (Storey County bill re: I-80 corridor between Vista Blvd. and the Wadsworth Interchange)

<u>AB 68</u> – Revises provisions governing the assessment imposed on certain counties for the operation of a regional facility for the treatment and rehabilitation of children. (China Spring)

- AB 92 Authorizes a board of county commissioners to create the office of county counsel
- AB 213 Revises provisions governing residential zoning
- AB 219 Makes various changes to the Open Meeting Law

<u>SB 20</u> – Allows County Board of Commissioners to establish a process by ordinance for filling board vacancies. Enabling only, not a mandate. If no process is established by ordinance, current process by which Governor appoints remains in place.

- <u>SB 75</u> Requires the election of a Registrar of Voters
- <u>SB 81</u> Revises provisions governing regional planning
- SB 142 Enacts the Homeless Persons' Bill of Rights
- <u>SB 155</u> Revises provisions relating to homeless persons.
- <u>SB 156</u> Revises the Open Meeting Law
