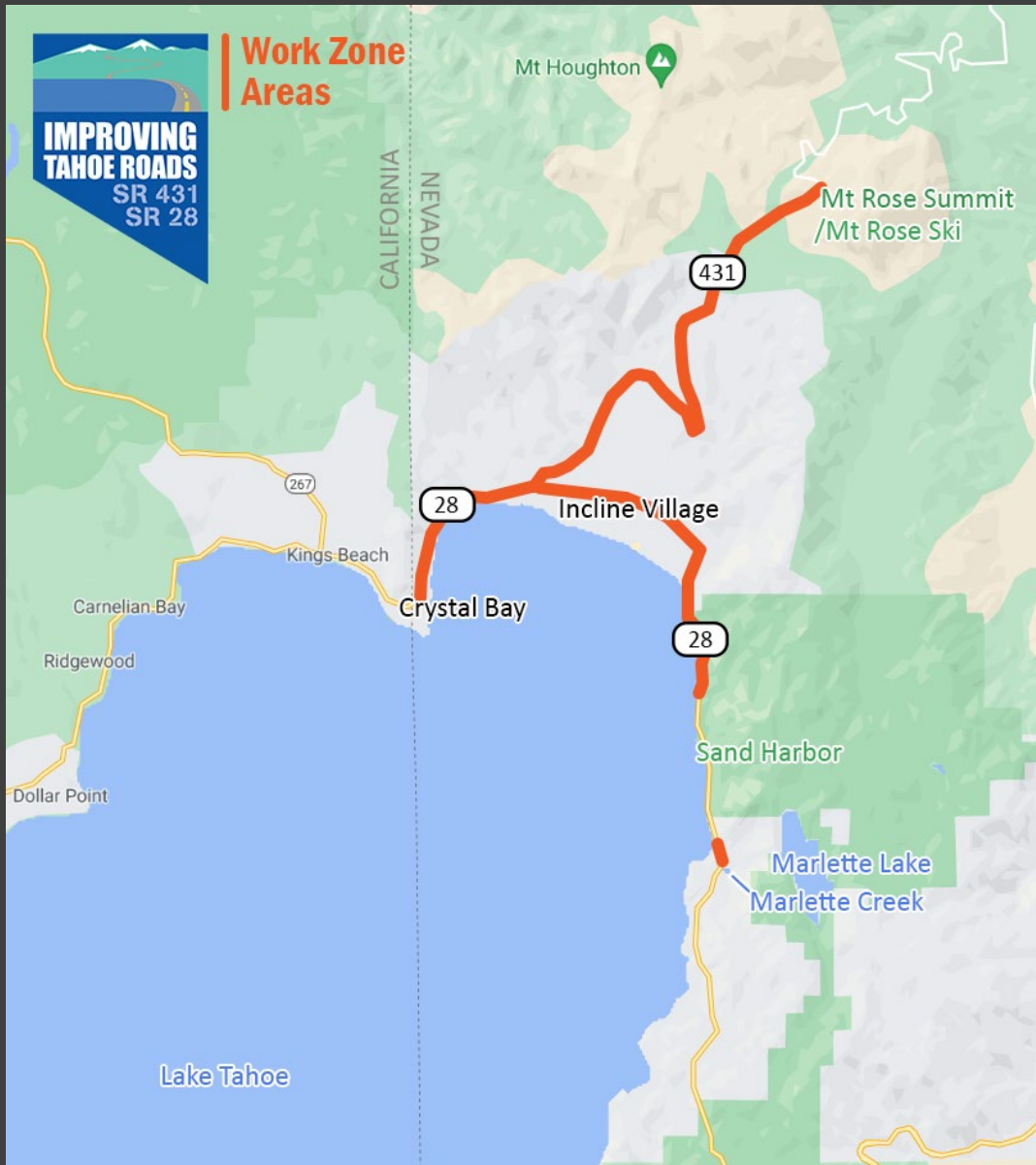

2021 CONSTRUCTION SEASON

Installed 57,000 linear feet of Intelligent Traffic Systems (ITS) conduit line.

- ITS conduit provides early installation of future electrical and communications including fiber optic cables, and is part of a broader plan to make high-speed internet more accessible throughout Nevada
- NDOT is investing in ITS conduit to provide communication and power for smarter roadway systems including cameras, road/weather information systems, traffic counters, traffic flow detectors, automated chain/snow tire control signage, and detection for runaway truck ramps

2022 CONSTRUCTION SEASON

- Finish installation of ITS conduit on SR-28 in towns of Crystal Bay and Incline Village
- Reconstruction of select roadway shoulders and cross slopes
- Repaving 3 to 4 inches of asphalt on both SR-431 and SR-28
- Enhanced sidewalk, ADA ramps, and driveways accesses
- Soil nailing along the aging timber wall along SR-28 south of the Memorial Point lookout
- Drainage improvements at Marlette Creek to enhance stormwater quality before it enters the lake

2022 CONSTRUCTION SEASON

- Adding **15,000 linear feet** of curb and gutter underneath guardrail along SR-28 adding three major benefits:
 1. Helps protect roadway slopes from erosion
 2. Collects and transfers water runoff that will help preserve the roadway
 3. Helps filter out runoff sediment before it enters the lake

2022 CONSTRUCTION SEASON

- Replacing **16,000 linear feet** of guardrail along SR-431 with new concrete barrier rail adding three major benefits:
 1. Helps protect roadway slopes from erosion
 2. Provides enhanced safety
 3. Reduced maintenance costs

TRAFFIC CONTROL





Traffic is reduced to a single lane in work zones. Flaggers will control traffic flow in these areas. Drivers can expect up to 30-minute delays.

2021 Season delays averaged less than 10-minutes!

Q&D Construction will satisfy Section 107.13 (a) by posting the nearest fire protection agencies phone number in all project vehicles or to the extent possible.

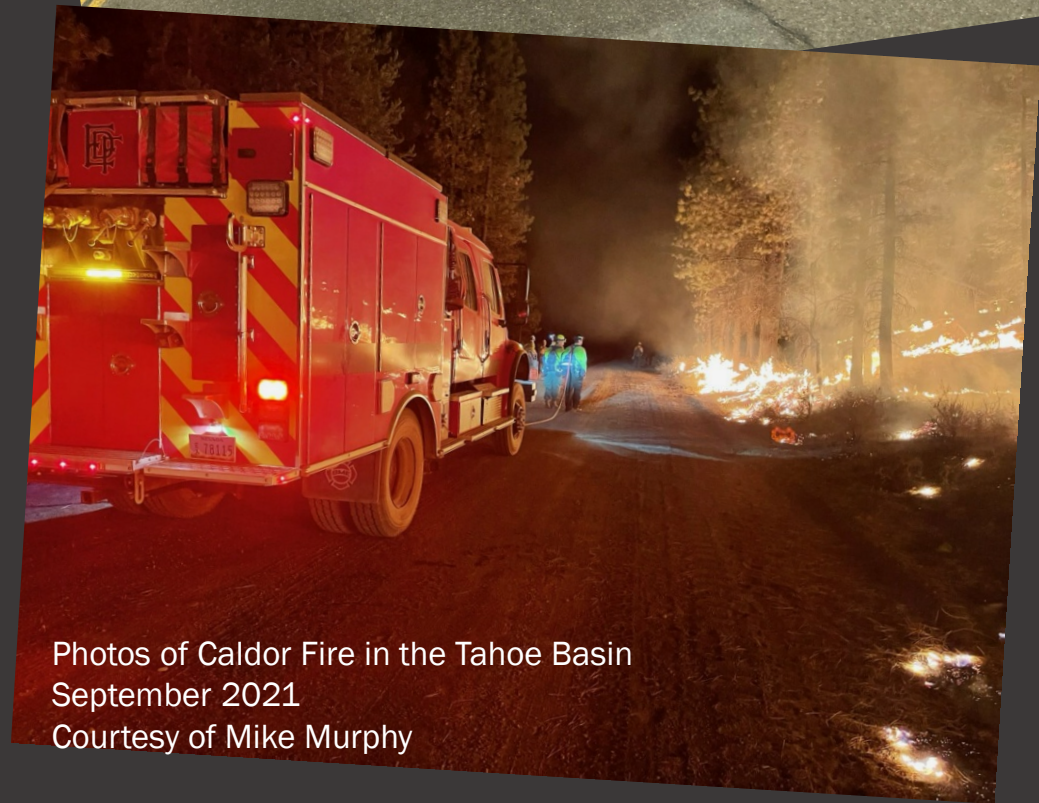




CALDOR FIRE
