Minutes of the regular meeting of the East Truckee Canyon Citizen Advisory Board held January 4, 2012 at the Stampmill Neighborhood Fire Department, Station 25, 400 Stampmill Dr., Wadsworth, Nevada

- 1.\* **CALL TO ORDER/PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE** - The meeting was called to order at 7:03 p.m. by Bambi Van Dyke, Chair. Ms. Van Dyke led the pledge of allegiance.

7. **NEW BUSINESS-** (The staff contact listed on items for Community Development may not be in attendance but can be contacted with code and policy questions.)
  - A.\* **Neighborhood Watch Program** – Teresa Aquila, Neighborhood Watch Coordinator was not unable to attend this meeting to provide information and to discuss the Neighborhood Watch Program and address questions from the CAB and audience. Ms. Aquila was available by telephone to address any questions from the community. There were no questions from the audience at this time. (This item was informational only and no action was taken by the CAB.)

    - Bambi Van Dyke stated that she would call Ms. Aquila after adjournment and with an update on any questions that have been heard from the community.
  - B.\* **Review of Development Code Articles Affecting the Truckee Canyon Area** – Chad Giesinger, Senior Planner, Department of Community Development was available to provide an overview of Washoe County Development Code Article 222, Truckee Canyon Area, Article 302, Allowed Uses, and Article 306, Accessory Uses and Structures and how these regulations relate to setbacks, placement, and allowed/permitted uses of mobile homes and accessory dwelling units in the Truckee Canyon planning area. Mr. Giesinger provided copies of the Regulation of Mobile Homes and Accessory Dwelling Units in the Truckee Canyon Planning Area. Mr. Giesinger discussed specific requirements for structures and grading adjacent to the Truckee River. Mr. Giesinger urged everyone to contact him with additional questions. (This item was informational only and no action will be taken by the CAB.)

**Comments and Concerns**

- In response to questions raised, Mr. Giesinger stated that modular homes are treated the same as on-site built dwellings provided they meet standards and codes. Code states that there is a 1500 square foot maximum or no more than 50% of the main dwelling square foot for an accessory dwelling.
- Mr. Giesinger stated that the trailer overlay was established in 1993 and there have been some revisions since then have been to correct problems that occurred.
- Mr. Giesinger discussed set-back requirements for various land use designations.
