Request


Extend the approval of Special Use Permit Case Number WSUP19-0003 for one additional year, until June 6, 2022. The original approval was for a new wireless cellular facility consisting of 150-foot-high monopole structure, equipment shelter, outdoor generator and LP tank.

Special Use Permit Findings

- Consistency. That the proposed use is consistent with the action programs, policies, standards and maps of the Master Plan and the High Desert Area Plan;
- Improvements. That adequate utilities, roadway improvements, sanitation, water supply, drainage, and other necessary facilities have been provided, the proposed improvements are properly related to existing and proposed roadways, and an adequate public facilities determination has been made in accordance with Division Seven;
- 3. <u>Site Suitability</u>. That the site is physically suitable for a telecommunications facility (monopole), and for the intensity of such a development;
- Issuance Not Detrimental. That issuance of the permit will not be significantly detrimental
 to the public health, safety or welfare; injurious to the property or improvements of adjacent
 properties; or detrimental to the character of the surrounding area;
- 5. <u>Effect on a Military Installation</u>. Issuance of the permit will not have a detrimental effect on the location, purpose or mission of the military installation.
- High Desert Area Plan Policy 2.3. The community character as described in the Character Statement can be adequately conserved through mitigation of any identified potential negative impacts



Recommendation

After a thorough review and analysis, Amendment of Conditions Case Number WAC21 0002 is being recommended for approval with conditions.
