

#### BACKGROUND:

On Tuesday, January 22nd, 2019, Washoe County GIS received a request from Dennis Wood (Attorney for New Deantronics, LTD and PWL, LLC) to rename a named public street from CLAYTON PL to NEW DEANTRONICS WAY south off Isidor Ct and west of Pyramid Way in Washoe County outside of any city limits. GIS has performed its due diligence by checking the street name against the Master Street Directory for any existing street name duplicates or similar phonetically-sounding street names for the purposes of Emergency Management.
