Open Space and Regional Park Commission Meeting August 3, 2021

SOUTH REGION HIGHLIGHTS

- Bowers Mansion hosted Programs on the Porch on Friday evenings in June. Attendance averaged 150 and was a successful return for this popular event.
- Bartley Ranch Regional Park hosted the K9 Partners fund-raising event on June 26th in coordination with the Sheriff's K9 unit. It was attended by approximately 2000 and involved numerous agencies displaying their equipment and functions for the community.
- Bartley Ranch hosted Evenings on the Ranch programs every Wednesday evening in July and hosted music, dancing, and a ballet at Hawkins Amphitheater in coordination with Artown.
