Volunteer Updates

- May Total Hours: There were a total of 1,564.75 volunteer hours. May was a good month for volunteering with mild weather, less COVID restrictions, and what appeared to be the desire of many people to get out of the house and be active.
- June Total Hours: There were a total of 713.5 hours. This is more hours than 2020 but less than an average year, most likely due to the heat.
- Some of the groups that volunteered over the last two months included: IBEW, Circle K, Andelin Family Farm, Target, Cub Scout Pack 55, UNR Key Club, Charles River Laboratories, Boy Scout Troop 46, Truckee Meadows Pickleball Club, SWCA Environmental Consultants, Panasonic, and groups of Master Gardeners and LDS Missionaries.
- The Keep Truckee Meadows Beautiful 2021 Great Community Cleanup took place on Saturday, May 1st from 8am-12pm. The participating Washoe County managed parks were Bartley Ranch Regional Park, Crystal Peak Park, Dorostkar Park, Lockwood Park, North Valleys Regional Park, and Rancho San Rafael Park. Projects included planting native vegetation, general beautification, litter cleanup, and weed removal. A total of 214 volunteers volunteered at our parks alone, for a grand total of 856 volunteer hours!
