FY 2023 Capital Improvement Projects (Fund 402 – General Fund)

- 1. South Valleys Regional Park Master Plan buildout -\$3MM
- 2. Melio Gaspari Water Play Park Safety Improvements -\$450,000
- 3. Virginia Foothills Park Playground Replacement \$400,000
- 4. Golden Valley Park Playground Replacement \$500,000
- 5. Ranch House Settling Mitigation \$131,000
- 6. Lemmon Valley Park Improvements \$650,000
- 7. Arboretum Cactus and Succulent Garden Design \$300,000
- 8. Regional Park Security Cameras \$220,000
