Highlights


- New palm tree introduced to collection (adapted to our climate)
- ◆ Three positions filled (Horticulture Assistant, 1.0 FTE Maintenance Worker -Parks, 0.75FTE Maintenance Worker - Parks)
- 2 Garden Kiosks were installed in the Arboretum
- Erosion control plan created
- Heavy damage from winter storms on collection
 - o 5 mature trees (DBH 12+ inches) fell over
- Classes for Arboretum staffing in proper tree care implemented
