## **Tent Group Camp Area**

This rustic, forested area is located in the southwest corner of the Day Use Area of the Park approximately 100 yards up the hill from the parking area via wooden steps. The area accommodates up to 50 people.

NO MOTOR VEHICLE ACCESS.

Food and gear must be carried up on foot

- The site is well shaded, providing several secluded areas for tents.
- The area is equipped with picnic tables, barbecue grill, group fire ring with benches, and a bear-proof food storage locker.
- Drinking water and a hose hook-up are available. Please bring a hose if you plan on having a fire.
- Restrooms & locking dumpster for this area are located at the base of the hill near the parking area.
- No electricity is available.
- Showers are available in the main campground (quarter-operated).
- Parking is limited to 15 vehicles per day. If you have more than 15 vehicles, the additional vehicle per day fee will apply.
- This camping area is located in the Day Use Area of the Park. The gate to this area is closed between the hours of 9:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m. Closing time in the spring and fall is 7:00 p.m.

## **RV Group Camp Area**

This secluded, forested drive-in area is located in the northeast corner of the campground. Area accommodates up to 100 people & up to 25 RV's, 32' max length.

- The site is equipped with picnic tables, large barbecue grill, benches around the group fire ring, bearproof food storage locker and a locking dumpster.
- Drinking water and a hose hook-up are available. Please bring a hose if you plan on having a fire.
- The area is equipped with vault-type restrooms with sinks and running water.
- Showers are available in the main campground (quarter-operated).
- No electricity is available.
- Any tents must be placed within 100 feet of the parking area.
- Parking is limited to 25 vehicles per day. If you have more than 25 vehicles, the additional vehicle per day fee will apply.

It is recommended that you view the areas before placing your reservation.

## **Group Area Guidelines**

- Check-in time is 2:00 p.m. and Check-out is 12:00 p.m. The Park Ranger will meet you at your reserved area. Please have your reservation paperwork.
- Please do not disturb or remove any plants, animals, geological or historical features located in the Park.
- Keep all food, beverages and hygiene products in the bear-proof locker or locked in vehicles whenever the site is unattended, and at night.
- Fires are permitted in the barbecue grill (charcoal only) and in the fire ring. Please keep your fires small and under control at all times, and please put your fire out with water, not dirt!
- Do not gather firewood. Firewood is available in the campground for a nominal fee, or you can bring your own.
- Please deposit all garbage in the locking dumpsters provided after each meal and before you go to bed.
- Keep pets leashed and under your control at all times.
- Quiet hours are from 10:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m. Generators are not allowed during this time.
- Amplified music is prohibited at all times in all Washoe County Parks.
