

## 2018 CANDIDATE QUALIFICATIONS

### JUSTICE OF THE PEACE

#### *Nonpartisan Office*

- Term of Office:** Six-year term (NRS 4.025); term begins on the first Monday of the January next after the appropriate general election
- Term Limits:** None
- Age Requirement:** 18 years of age at the time of election  
(Nevada Constitution, Art. 2, Sec.1; Art. 15, Sec. 3)
- Voter Status:** Must be a qualified elector  
(Nevada Constitution, Art. 2, Sec. 1), (NRS 293.485)
- Ineligible:** If ever been removed or retired from any judicial office by the Commission on Judicial Discipline. A person **IS** still eligible if a decision to remove or retire him from a judicial office is pending appeal before the Supreme Court or has been overturned by the Supreme Court (NRS 4.010 (1))
- Other:** Must have a high school diploma or equivalent. Reno-Verdi and Sparks Justice of the Peace must be a licensed attorney admitted to practice law in the courts of the State of Nevada at the time of his election or appointment, and has been licensed and admitted to practice law in the State of Nevada, another state or the District of Columbia for not less than 5 years at any time preceding his election or appointment. (NRS 4.010)
- Residency Requirements:** 30 days next preceding the date of the close of filing of declarations of candidacy for the office he seeks (**December 13, 2017**) (NRS 293.1755 (1))
- Filing fee:** \$100.00, payable by cash, certified check or cashier's check (NRS 293.193)
- Elected by:** Respective Township
