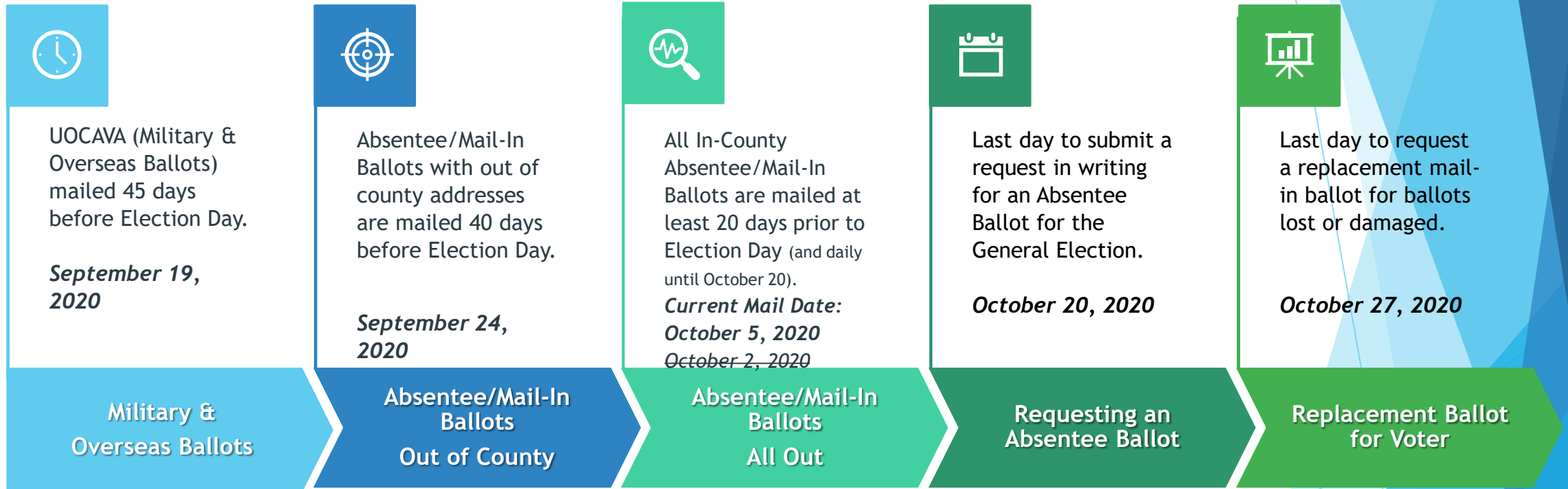


2020 General Election Absentee/Mail-In Ballots

Voters may now request permanent absentee ballot status for any reason by submitting a written request to the Office of the Registrar of Voters.

NOTE: If you have requested permanent absentee ballot status and you surrender your paper ballot to vote at a polling location, your permanent status may be removed, and you will need to resubmit your request again to reinstate your permanent status.

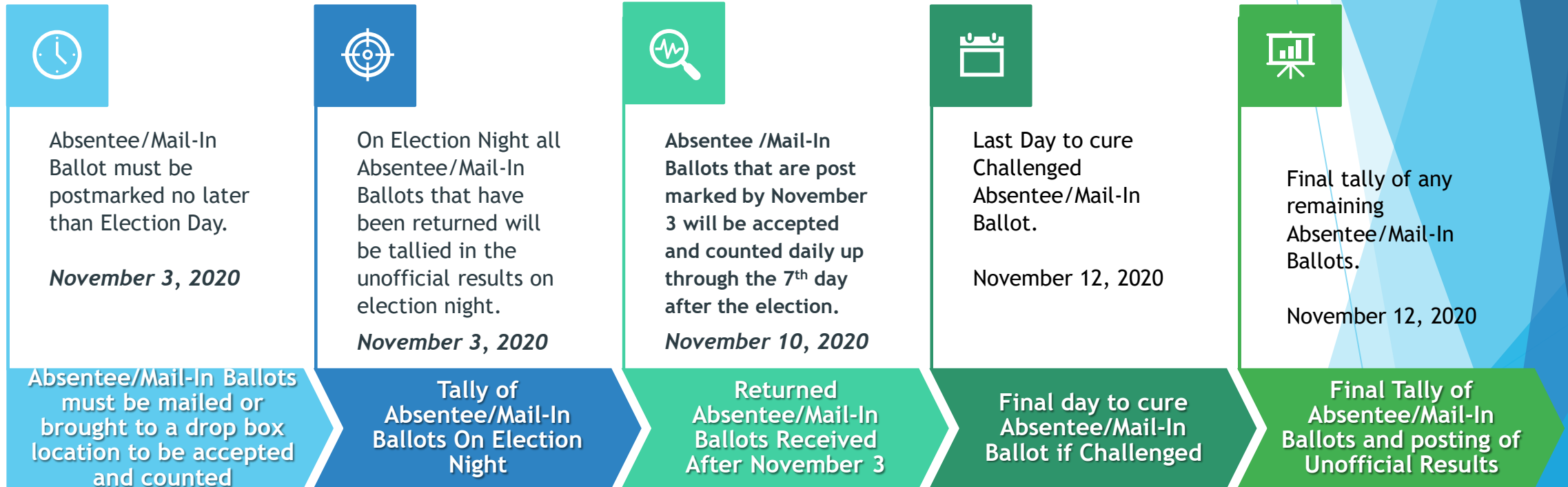
After the last day to request an absentee ballot, and IF you have been called away from work, have been injured or hospitalized, or have another qualifying event, you may be eligible to request and vote an emergency ballot.
