Voter Registration Drive

It is strongly recommended that individuals, groups and organizations that wish to register voters, but do not want to become Field Registrars attend a class for voter registration drives

- Any individual or organization may distribute voter registrations applications
- Such individuals/organizations are subject to all applicable state and federal laws
- Registration rules and procedures will be explained

To qualify as a **Field Registrar**, you must:

- Be a registered Voter in Washoe County
- Not be a candidate for nomination or election
- Have picture identification and proof of current residence address
- Successfully complete a Field Registrar Training Class.

About **Field Registrar** Class

There are regulations and responsibilities associated with being a Field Registrar.

In class you will learn:

- Permissible and prohibited policies and procedures for registering voters
- Registration deadlines
- Custody of registration
