2018 General Poll Worker Recruitment Efforts

We will soon be sending an email or letter asking if you want to volunteer to work the upcoming November election.

Once again, you will be expected to attend In-Person training, along with completing the online training. In-Person training will be held in October.



Poll Worker Training Classes

With so much new information that needs to be learned and the request for more hands on training, it has been decided to have separate training classes for Intake Specialists/Early Voting Associates and Managers/Assistant Managers.

We will also increase the number of Poll Books available for use during training so that everyone has a chance to learn and practice various scenarios until they feel comfortable with the process.

The on-line training and poll worker manuals will be going through some adjustments as well based on your comments and our experience from the Primary Election, so keep those suggestions coming in.

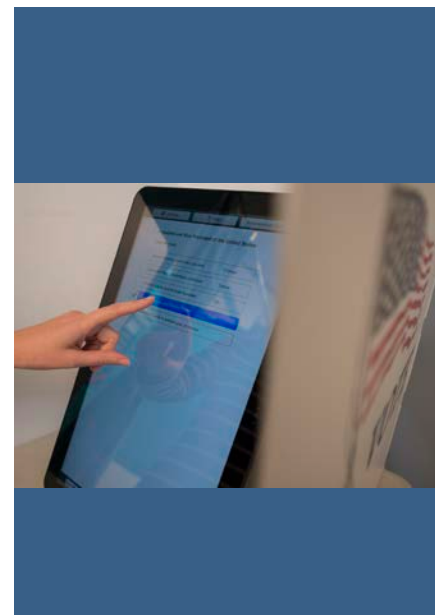
2018 Primary Election Statistics
